Brief Description

By special arrangement with the Marblehead Arts Association (MAA), this second comprehensive workshop is intended as a sequel to my April sessions, and it will cover more specific watercolor techniques, in addition to those discussed and applied in the first (various wash methods – wet-on-wet, dry-brush, glazing, blending, sharp and soft edges, dilution control). The focus will be specifically on controlled and limited palette color choices, and the spectrum of values and hues derived from such choices. A range of exercises will allow painters to explore the powerful effects of warm and cool palettes, and the range of contrast, while exploring value structures for simple and more complex compositions – either with given imagery, or from a student's own work. Each dynamic session will delve more deeply into more complicated aspects of color theory. From the instructor's demos, participants will learn more finessed methods for arranging a subject and the structure of a composition. Also by developing a practice for applying small studies, and thence streamlining production of a finished painting, students will achieve more visually effective results, which make paintings come alive. Experimentation and interpretative methods will also be demonstrated and encouraged during the workshop. This unique sequel workshop will comprise two studio classes, for about 8 hours each day, with a 45-60 minute lunch break, at the Hooper Mansion.

Ability Requirements

The workshop will be an opportunity to continue one's study and progress gained from the first sessions, or for others, preferably with some painting and workshop experience. MAA and the instructor will provide a relaxed place for participants to interactively develop their skills. With a likely diversity of skills, capabilities will vary widely, but one-on-one instruction will be tailored to each individual's level. Expectations are for a creative, exciting environment from which the collective energies and interests will allow everyone to learn much more than otherwise struggling to discover alone. Also, expectations are for making "mistakes", and for having fun while learning with an award-winning watercolorist.
