Course Description

On the historic, scenic island of Nantucket, an exciting plein-air watercolor workshop will be offered by Mr. Costantino. A small group of participants will share accommodations at a private home in the island's quiet Surfside section, with a continental breakfast provided each day. Local islanders or artists who have accommodations may also join in. A van will be available for class travel to paint at nearby locations – downtown, the harbor, Sconset Village, Madaket and other scenic areas. The workshop will comprise outdoor sketch sessions of three days, for about 8 hours each day, with a 60 minute lunch break at a local eatery or with a lunch box on site. Indoor sessions will occur if weather is unfavorable. Registration is available for an entire week, or for the first or the second of two 3-day sessions.

This intensive and comprehensive workshop will expose students to the freshness and spontaneity of painting this venerable Island's enticing vistas on-site. Daily demos will show the critical choices of view selection, composition, color mixing, and brush techniques. In review sessions & demos, participants will learn ways to simplify subjects, while learning to see and achieve the dynamics of light, contrast, value, movement, space, texture, etc., which make paintings come alive. Participants will explore and apply various wash methods – wet-on-wet, glazing, blending, edges, dilution control - while capturing their own vision of each site. Experimentation will be encouraged, to bring a heightened awareness of the many available approaches for painting plein-air (or in studio). Relaxed reviews will occur at the end of the day, with opportunities for unstructured painting time.

Participant's abilities should include basic drawing, a comfortable level of familiarity or experience with watercolor, and some plein-air painting experience. With an expected diversity of skills, capabilities will vary widely, but instruction will be tailored to each individual's level. Expectations are for a supportive environment from which the collective energies and interests will allow everyone to learn much more than otherwise struggling to discover alone. Also, expectations are for enjoying the unique environment of Nantucket, and having fun while learning.
